Portfolio

Binder must be at least 1" and of good quality. You will need five (5) dividers labeled according to the *Portfolio Sections* on the front side of this page. You must keep the binder organized in the order of the Table of Contents provided. Hole reinforcements are very helpful to keep papers in the binder. The *Portfolio* is used extensively to help study for tests/quizzes, complete projects, and keep records of all PDNs, homework, tests/quizzes, keyboarding grades, and projects.

Homework

Be sure to have your header completely filled in. If any assignment or homework has been assigned to be completed online and you do not have access to the Internet, see the teacher for a printed copy.
